<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the outset, Hon'ble Mr. Mohammed Nasim, Hon'ble Chair, Bangladesh CCM and Minister, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare welcomed all the members to the 80th BCCM meeting. • He requested Syed Monjurul Islam, Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and Vice Chair BCCM to steer the meeting in accordance with predetermined agenda. • The 80th BCCM meeting was held on 18 September 2014 and the minutes were electronically circulated to all and hard copies were provided in the folders. The minutes of the 80th BCCM meeting were taken as read and confirmed after little discussion.

Government	Respected Mr. Syed Monjurul Islam, Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and Vice Chair, BCCM requested BCCM members to give comments and feedback, if any on 80 th CCM meeting minutes. .
Chairperson	Respected Vice Chair and Secretary MOHFW said there was no comments and feedback on the 80th BCCM meeting minutes except little correction of date. So it was confirmed and approved by the BCCM.
Decision	BCCM confirmed and approved the 80th meeting minutes with a little correction of signature date.

Agenda Item # 2	Framework Agreement with Global Fund, Deduction of US\$ 4.2 million as means of recovery misappropriated money by PMUK, litigation and court case and Immunity & Privileges.
Conflict of Interest	N/A
Summary of the discussion on the framework agreement	
<p>The salient features of framework agreement were shared with the BCCM members for everyone's general understanding about the conditionalities in the New Funding Model as well. Threadbare discussion on litigation and court cases against GFATM took place with regard to misappropriation of about US\$ 1.9 million by PMUK for which GFATM decided to deduct US\$ 4.2 million as a means of recovery from HIV allocation under NFM with a view to compensating the losses and saving the donors by GFATM.</p>	
Constituency/ Sector	Write content of contributions below
Government	Mr. Zahid Maleque, Hon'ble State Minister for MOHFW proposed to undertake sincere and honest action against the defaulters to suspend the license of PMUK which was issued by NGO Bureau. MOHFW needs to discuss with a lawyer especially Attorney General to find out solutions to the problem.
Government	<p>Respected Mr. Syed Monjurul Islam, Vice Chair CCM and Secretary of MOHFW informed that Hon'ble Minister is very much concerned about the Global Fund's letter of 5 February 2015. Hon'ble Minister already requested Global Fund to review the case of deducting such a big amount of money. He is now concerned about two things, one is misappropriation of money by PMUK and the second one is granting immunities and privileges to the Global Fund. Government of Bangladesh is not a part of misappropriation of money which was done by a non-government organization. It is now sub-judice under the civil court. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare should not intervene in the independent action of judiciary.</p> <p>He hoped that Global Fund should not penalize program as well as people of Bangladesh for</p>

	<p>PMUK's misappropriation and the people were quite innocent in this regards. Bangladesh has done quite substantial progress in terms of care and treatment for HIV, Malaria and TB.</p> <p>Respected Secretary, MOHFW also proposed channelizing Global Fund Money through government. BCCM would not like to see further situation like PMUK again.</p> <p>Ms. Sultana Afroz, Joint Secretary, Economic Relations Division (ERD) informed BCCM about the decisions of inter-ministerial meeting held on 12 February at ERD. The decisions were that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs would review Privileges and Immunities claimed by Global Fund after reviewing some examples of the neighboring countries. She also informed that NBR will look into the possibilities for granting tax exemption on GF materials. After getting information from MOFA and NBR, ERD will call another inter-ministerial meeting for these issues related to signature the GF Framework agreement.</p> <p>Prof. Dr. Deen Md. Noorul Huq, Director General of Health Services suggested that BCCM Chair should talk to Attorney General about withdrawal of the cases from the court and actions shall be undertaken to dismiss PMUK's license as the people should not suffer for their misappropriation and wrong activities.</p> <p>The Hon'ble Minister expressed his personal intent in respect of granting Privileges & Immunities having consensus of other ministries if there are no legal bindings.</p>
Multilateral Bilateral Organizations (ML/BL)	<p>Ms. Meaghan Byers, First Secretary, Canadian High Commission informed BCCM that donors who provide fund to the Global Fund have consulted their Head Quarters and agree that the Global Fund's processes to recover misappropriated funds must be followed. She also encouraged the BCCM to write a follow-up letter to GF, accepting the proposal for deduction of money, so that Bangladesh can move forward with the new grants and the GoB shall continue to Work towards granting Privileges and Immunities.</p> <p>Mr. Leo Kenny, Country Director, UNAIDS informed that Global Fund new board decision asked every country to give Immunity & Privileges where there is GF funding. He suggested that a simple follow-up letter signed by BCCM Chair could be sent to the Global Fund for accepting the grant to retain this money instead of deduction. The letter shall contain that BCCM is working on Privileges and immunities and BCCM also working on the court cases and litigation issues.</p> <p>He also suggested that the GF should be requested to deduct US\$ 2.1 million instead of US\$ 4.2 million considering Bangladesh peoples' sufferings. He hoped that the GF will agree and sign the framework agreement quickly.</p> <p>Dr. N. Paranietharan WHO Representative to Bangladesh recommended that BCCM should write a follow-up letter based on the previous letter including decisions of Inter-ministerial meeting held on 12 February at ERD and the decisions of 81st BCCM meeting held on 19 February at Ministry of Health and Family Welfare today.</p> <p>Dr. Sukumar Sarker from USAID opined that the GF has taken decision to recover the money on the basis of OIG report as an audit issue and to solve the court case. If BCCM writes the second letter, BCCM needs to close the matter of past audit issues and enters into the new Framework Agreement under the New Funding Model.</p>
Academia	<p>Prof. Dr. Sharfuddin Ahmed suggested that BCCM staff or MOHFW could send the follow-up the letter with a request to the GF to deduct 50% of the proposed money of total US\$ 4.2 million. BCCM should not delay showing disgraceful things to GF. He also suggested that BCCM needs to take administrative action against PMUK and shall request NGO Bureau to suspend PMUK's registration and license.</p>
PRs	<p>Mr. Michael McGrath, Country Director, Save the Children expressed that the Government of Bangladesh had already taken action to address some key demands by the GF (e.g, immunities and privileges) and could not legally take formal action as a government to address other issues. He expressed that it was unfair to double the penalty. It is really unjustifiable that the Bangladesh people who suffer from the three fatal diseases should have to pay for misappropriation by an SR under the Save the Children.</p>

Chairperson	BCCM will write a follow up letter on the basis of discussion of this meeting and BCCM will request the GF to review their decisions with regard to deducting US\$ 4.2 million as a means of recovery due to misappropriation.
Decisions	BCCM will write a letter again to Global Fund to inform the progress of Bangladesh on issues of Immunities and Privileges and the court cases and taking administrative penal action against PMUK. This letter shall include the decisions of inter-ministerial meetings held at ERD on 12 February and BCCM meeting held on 19 February 2015.



