9th KAP and PLHIV Constituency Meeting



9thKAP and PLHIV constituency meeting is held on 11 December, 2017 at PIACT Bangladesh office, conference room, Dhaka. Around 35 participants from different community group attended the meeting including BCCM Coordinator Mr. Manaj Kumar Biswas, Deputy Coordinator. Mr. Mohammad Harun-Or-Rasid. SWN General Secretary Mrs. Aleya Akter Lily welcomed all the participants and requested Mr. Birazto moderate.

Mr. Biraz (Bandhu Social Wealfare) gave a short briefing about the meeting with its objective. He shared the agenda of this meeting and requested all to give their introduction. After introduction Moderator requested Mr. Manaj Kumar, BCCM Coordinator to present a brief introduction about Bangladesh Country Coordinating Mechanism (BCCM) as most of the participants are newcomer at the meeting. It is mentioned that KAP and PLHA Constituency already organized eight such types of meeting. Mr. Manaj Kumar presented a nice introduction about BCCM.

2.	CCM update for the last six months by CCM Secretariat	<p>BCCM Deputy Coordinator Mr. Harun-Or-Rasid presented last six months' update of BCCM. Key activities are as bellows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grant confirmation is made and entered into by the global fund to fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria. - Oversight committee (OC) will visit HIV center at Lalbag on 18 October, and TB center on 22 October, 17 - OC will visit outside of Dhaka in Nov and Dec, 17 <p>Based on the presentation of BCCM update some questions are asked by the participants, for instance,</p> <p>Mrs. Shahnaz (FSW) asked, Will we go to visit outside of Dhaka?</p> <p>Mr. Manaj Kumar informed that CCM members and oversight committee members are comprises the visit team.</p> <p>Katha (Hizra) wanted to know Members' of responsibility in CCM to the community people.</p> <p>Mr. Manaj Kumar discussed responsibility of CCM about community people.</p> <p>Mrs.Chumki, We wanted to know CCM meeting issue.</p> <p>Mr. Biraz, Bandhu Social Welfare Society (BSWS) recognized it as an important question. CSW Network repetitive has to convey message of CCM meeting issue to the Community people regularly.</p> <p>Kajal (FSW) said, Can we be member in CCM out site of Dhaka?</p> <p>Mr. Manaj Kumar said, Yes You will be member in CCM of site Dhaka under election process.</p>

Mr. Manaj Kumar told some decisions of special HIV meeting, such as

- A draft minutes of the special HIV meeting has been shared to all KAP groups and now need to approval from chair.
- Govt. will take over the treatment and care arrangement from NGOs from 1st October, 2017. Govt. will observe it up-to December and if there will any difficulties or problems honorable minister, MoHFW will take proper initiative by January 2018.

Mr. Shahed shared the experience of retreat meeting. He also raised the issue of funding in absence of global fund at the retreat meeting.

Mr. Hafizuddin Munna explained the present situation of treatment and care system of PLHIV and he urged for smooth transition of this system so that no-one becomes deprived from proper care. He also urged to create special corner, like ART corner in the six hospitals from where treatment and care is facilitated now. He mentioned that in BSMMU still written as HIV corner and PLHIV people are discriminated there. He also highlighted community Network for strengthen and Capacity.

Update on BCCM re-treat	<p>Mr. Shahid shared a brief update about BCCM retreat which was organized on 26th September at Dhaka Club.</p> <p>There was a key exercise took place at the re-treat about how the country HIV programme will continue with support from Govt. once Global Fund phase out (slowly) from Bangladesh.</p>	BCCM secretariat will share the notes of re-treat soon.
4.	World AIDS Day and provision of lunching of Community Forum in Bangladesh	<p>A proposal of lunching Community Forum of KAP constituencies during celebration of World AIDS DAY 2017 has been raised by Bandhu.</p> <p>All KAP constituencies agreed to launch Community Forum at AIDS Day, 2017 Postponed Launch Community Forum, So Bandhu take next step as soon as possible.</p>	Mr. Shale told that they will communicate with OKUP to finalize this launching
5.	AOB	10 th KAP and PLHIV constituency meeting will be held at OKUP	Shakirul will host the next meeting.
