Åt the commencement, Chair of the meeting welcomed all participants. At the end of self-introduction, the Chair of the meeting directed BCCM Coordinator to proceed to agenda-wise discussion.

DISCUSSION(S) AND DECISION(S):

Agenda Item # 1: Approval of 45th BCCM OC meeting minutes. .

BCCM Secretariat: Mr. Manaj Kumar Biswas, BCCM Coordinator, BCCM Secretariat informed the meeting that signed copy of 45th Oversight Committee meeting minutes has been shared with stakeholders electronically and no comments have been received yet, in any form. He requested the meeting to endorse the meeting decisions.

<u>The Chairperson</u>: The Chairperson of the meeting requested all participants to comment, if any. If no comment is made, he proposed to endorse 45st BCCM Oversight Committee meeting minutes.

<u>Decision:</u> The 46th meeting of the BCCM Oversight Committee endorsed decisions of 45th BCCM Oversight Committee meeting.

Agenda Item # 2: Update on C19RM Funding Request.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that Bangladesh have prepared C19RM Wave-2 which was endorsed in 116th BCCM meeting on 02 March 2027. It was planned to submit by 20 March 2023. But The Global Fund Country Team, during their visit in Bangladesh, suggested to submit the proposal by 12 May 2023 so that proposal development committee can concentrate on Grant Cycle 7 funding request. Accordingly, C19RM Wave 2 Funding will be submitted by 12 May 2023.

He also informed the meeting that The Global Fund Country Team is visiting Bangladesh and conducting meeting with Management Staff of PRs and other development partners. PRs requested to reschedule the Oversight Committee meeting but considering the upcoming FR submissions and busy schedule of Ministry Officials, it could not be done. He requested PRs' representatives to update the meeting if there is any change in the funding request which was endorsed.

PR representative(s): Dr. Mushfiqur Rahman, Program Operation Advisor, NMEP informed the meeting that proposed activities are same endorsed. He presented the proposal in brief (presentation attached as annexure A) and focused on following issues:

- Considering the timeline of submission and other procedure, the program implementation has rescheduled to January 2024 December 2025.
- The exchange rate has been updated according to the current rate. As exchange rate of US dollar has raised against BDT, the total requirement of fund in USD has changed and updated accordingly.

Dr. Tasmiah Selim, Senior Manager, BRAC informed the meeting that they have considered the same exchange rate previously. Thus, C19RM Wave 2 application remained same as endorsed. She presented summary of the funding request (attached herewith as annexure B).

Md. Akhtaruzzaman, Senior Manager, ASP informed the meeting that HIV program has only one activity i.e. nutrition support for PLHIV. He also informed the meeting that it was discussed and endorsed in last BCCM meeting.

<u>Decision(s):</u> The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee acknowledged the progress of .

C19RM Wave-2 Funding Request.

Agenda Item #3: Update on HIV PRs' management cost review.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that the Global Fund has requested to consolidate non-government HIV PRs' grant. In response to this recommendation, previous Oversight

Committee Chair Kazi Zebunnessa Begum, Additional Secretary (former), World Health Wing, Health Services Division conducted separate meetings with HIV PRs, HIV Experts from Oversight Committee and related Development partners. The issue, including results of these meetings were discussed. BCCM Oversight committee formed a committee, headed by Joint Secretary (WH), HSD, to review the program management cost non-government HIV PRs'. The review committee visited icddr,b and Save The Children to review their management cost and find a way to reduce management cost. Both PRs has proposed to keep their program management cost within 22% where the Global Fund set standard will be maintained. The review committee also conducted another meeting to decide recommendation for non-government HIV PRs' on management cost. BCCM Coordinator requested Dr. Saima Khan, Country Director, UNAIDS and member PRs management cost review committee to present summary of their visit and meetings.

PRs Program Management Cost Review Committee: On behalf of the review committee Dr. Saima Khan, Country Director, UNAIDS explained that two PRs of HIV grants are working with different key population where both have significant success. Moreover, the program is working for integration with Government Health System. Thus, any change in PRs will hamper the integration process as any new PR will require to start implementation after establishing trust with the KP communities and this will require time. Besides, grant consolidation will not save significant amount of money. In these circumstances, continuation of current PRs is important for the sustainability of the program.

Dr. Saima Khan also informed the meeting that during the visit the team reviewed program management costs of both PRs and recommended a decrease in the program management costs. On the matter of the decrease proposed by Save the Children, she mentioned that the team agreed that the SCI headquarter costs should be considered for further decrease than proposed and the decrease made for in-country staff costs could be less considering program quality.

Both PRs opined that they will be able to maintain program management cost below 22%. As the Global Funds' ceiling is 25%, agreed limit should be acceptable to The Global Fund.

<u>The Chairperson</u>: The Chairperson of the meeting requested all concerned to comment on the outcome of the activities by PRs Management Cost Review Committee. If all members agree with the outcome/recommendations of the committee, it will be sent to next BCCM meeting.

<u>Oversight Committee member(s):</u> Dr. Asif Mujtaba Mahmud, Senior Consultant, Asgar Ali Hospital and TB Expert Member of BCCM Oversight Committee queried about the 22% limit is imposed by whom. He opined that if it is imposed, it may hamper their program planning standard.

PRs Program Management Cost Review Committee: Dr. Saima Khan replied that the limit was set by these PRs themselves. The committee identified some cost items during the visit and discussed about possible reduction. According to the discussion, they committed to set the limit. She also raised concern about the consequence if LFA verification finds the program management cost above 22%.

<u>PR representative(s):</u> Dr. Shamim Jahan, Deputy Country Director, SCI Bangladesh confirmed that there is no chance of exceeding the limit in the budget later on as they are adequately experienced with LFA verification. He also opined that the consequences of deviation from the decisions are well known to every stakeholder specially PRs. Thus, there is almost no chance of deviation from the decision presented here.

Dr. A. K. M. Masud Rana, Program Coordinator, icddr,b also agreed with Dr. Shamim Jahan and expressed their commitment also.



<u>Decision(s)</u>: The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee acknowledged the PRs' management cost review committee activities.

The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee also decided to send the recommendations of the Management Cost Review Committee to next BCCM meeting.

Agenda Item # 4: Update on HIV Funding Request for Grant Cycle 7 (GC-7) for the period of 2024-2026.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that Bangladesh has submitted TB and Malaria Funding request for Grant Cycle 7 on 20 March 2023. These requests have been reviewed by The Global Fund country team and updated after discussion with respective PRs. Updated funding requests have sent to Technical Review Panel for their review and approval.

According to the decision of 115th BCCM meeting decision, Bangladesh is going to submit HIV/AIDS funding request under Grant Cycle 7 allocation for the period of 2024-2026 by 29 May 2023. Funding request development committee, headed by Dr. Ahmedul Kabir, ADG (Planning and Development) is working on the funding request development.

He also informed that BCCM Secretariat has requested for BCCM meeting date within 15-20 May 2023 as HSD Officials including Hon'ble Minister, MOHFW will be busy with World Health Assembly during last 10 days of this month. As the funding request needs to be endorsed before submission i.e. 29 May 2023, BCCM meeting should be organized before 20 May 2023. In this circumstance, he requested HIV Funding request development committee to submit first draft by 10th May 2023 so that BCCM Secretariat can share with stakeholders for their comments and feedback providing adequate time. He requested ASP representative to update the meeting on the progress of funding request development.

PR representative(s): Dr. Shah Mohammad Jashim Uddin, Director ASP informed the meeting that funding request development is in progress. They are planning to submit first draft on 12th May 2023, if allowed.

<u>BCCM Secretariat</u>: BCCM Coordinator opined that HIV Funding Request sharing on 12th May 2023 will be okay for public sharing and stakeholder sharing.

<u>PR representative(s):</u> Md. Akhtaruzzaman, Senior Manager, ASP added that they are considering USD 27.39 million as budget ceiling in total for three PRs (\$25.39m HIV allocation, \$01m incentive fund and \$01m for removing human rights and gender barriers). He also clarified that they will submit Funding Request Narrative, Budget, Performance Framework (PF) and Health Product Management Template (HPMT) for sharing with stakeholder by 12th May 2023.

<u>The Chairperson:</u> The Chairperson of the meeting requested proposal development committee to review the allocation letter and prepare funding request accordingly.

Decision(s): The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee

- acknowledged the progress of HIV funding request development.
- also decided that ASP would submit first draft of HIV FR to BCCM by 12th May 2023 for public sharing and stakeholders sharing
 - also decided to send the HIV Funding Request to next BCCM meeting for endorsement.



Agenda Item # 5: CCM Reconstitution and Orientation of Newly formed BCCM and other committees.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that BCCM Membership has been reconstituted. Members are selected/elected on the basis of our governance manual. Some are nominated (GoB representatives), some are selected by constituency (multilateral and bi-lateral members are selected by Donor Consortium and PLWD-TB & PLWD-Malaria are selected by NATAB and Hill District Council respectively), some are selected by Evolution Committee members (Academia & Researcher and Private Sector) and some are elected through voting process. He requested Mohammad Harun Or Rasid, Deputy Coordinator, BCCM Secretariat to show new members list of different committee on the screen.

Deputy Coordinator showed list of all committee members (attached herewith as annexure C) in the screen and BCCM Coordinator described members nomination/election process. Others committee members are also shown in the screen and described accordingly. He also informed the meeting that some members are from the previous committees. Few of them are regularly absent for long time. Thus, he requested the committee to decide on this.

<u>Oversight Committee member(s)</u>: Dr. Asif Mujtaba Mahmud opined that BCCM Secretariat should communicate with the members who are absent for long but included in new committee so that we can know his/her interest to contribute BCCM. If they do not show interest, new members should be included.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that The Global Fund has introduced Ethics Committee. It was described in the guideline that Ethics Committee members should be independent and will not be a member of any other committee. Thus, the Ethics Committee members are proposed accordingly. Proposed nine (09) members committee is headed by Md. Ashadul Islam, former Senior Secretary and Vice Chair (GoB), BCCM. And Mr. Debashish Nag will represent Ethics Committee in BCCM Oversight Committee.

He explained that PRs representatives are also part of these committees. BCCM Secretariat has already requested PRs to send their representative's name. Most of them have confirmed their participation as previous. Some PRs didn't reply back and will be considered as continuation of previous membership format.

BCCM Coordinator also informed the meeting that the procurement committee remained same except one change. Joint Secretary (WH) is proposed as Chair of the procurement committee instead of Deputy Secretary (WH-2) while Deputy Secretary (WH-2) will remain as member in the committee.

BCCM Coordinator added that the recruitment committee remained same except one addition. Taskforce proposed to include Director (finance), DGHS. The proposal will be further discussed and committee will be updated accordingly.

<u>PR representative(s):</u> Md. Akhtaruzzaman, Senior Manager, ASP queried whether this recruitment committee will cover the recruitment which are related to government PRs.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator replied to the query that this recruitment committee will work for BCCM Secretariat related recruitment only.

BCCM Coordinator also informed the meeting that, according to the Global Fund guideline, BCCM and Oversight Committee Chair and Vice Chairs are the member of Executive committee. We have proposed chair and Vice Chair of Oversight Committee. But Chair and Vice Chair of BCCM will be

elected. A three members commission has been formed where Additional Secretary (WH) is the Chair and Mr. Debashish Nag and Dr. Saima Khan are two members. The Commission will conduct meeting soon to declare election procedure and timing.

BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that The Global Fund CCM Hub has appointed international consultant for orientation to newly selected member of BCCM Mr. Rob ward will be visiting Bangladesh for the orientation. He informed that orientation of Oversight Committee members is urgent and can be conducted in June 2023 as May 2023 will be very busy months for MOHFW Officials. If this meeting agrees with the proposal, BCCM Secretariat will communicate with The Global Fund proposing the schedule in June 2023 for orientation of Oversight Committee members. Schedule for orientation of BCCM members will be fixed in next BCCM meeting.

<u>Decision(s)</u>: The 46rd meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee:

- acknowledged the progress of BCCM Reconstitution and reviewed newly formed Committees
- also decided to send newly formed committees to next BCCM meeting with some update/correction for endorsement as attached annexure-C
- also decided that the Orientation of BCCM Oversight Committee members will be scheduled on 1st week of June 2023 or onwards after endorsement of BCCM Standing Committees including BCCM Oversight and Strategy Committee.

Agenda Item # 6: BCCM Governance Manual and other Operations manual update.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that BCCM Governance Manual and other operations manual needs to be updated as new guideline and requirements by the Global Fund new CCM policy has been added in new CCM e.g. Human right expert in Oversight Committee, Ethics committee etc. The Global Fund will provide necessary support for the update. BCCM need to decide to update the Governance Manual and Other Operations Manual.

<u>Chair of the meeting:</u> The Chairperson of the meeting requested BCCM Coordinator to communicate with The Global Fund and take necessary action to update BCCM Governance Manual.

Decision(s): The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee

- acknowledged necessity of updating BCCM Governance Manual and directed BCCM Coordinator to take necessary action;
- decided to amend the BCCM Governance Manual and other Operational Manual as soon as possible after new CCM on board
- decided to ask Technical Assistance from the GF CCM Hub for the amendments of BCCM Governance Manual and other Operational Manuals

Agenda Item #7: Update on BCCM Secretariat budget 2023.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that BCCM Secretariat has submitted Costed Workplan for 2023 on 12th December 2022. After submission, the budget has been verified by LFA in March-April 2023 and it is for the first time that BCCM Budget verified by the LFA after CCM endorsement. The LFA conducted debrief meeting with BCCM Secretariat on 09th March 2023.

Unfortunately, BCCM Secretariat has not received neither final costed workplan nor agreement for this cycle. BCCM Secretariat has sent several follow-up emails but GF Secretariat did not reply yet. Currently BCCM Secretariat is spending in accordance with last year's budget and using cash balance from CCM Evolution Fund.

<u>The Chairperson:</u> The Chairperson of the meeting requested BCCM Coordinator to further communicate with The Global Fund CCM Hub to know the reason. If no response is received, Oversight Committee Chair will decide next step.

<u>Decision(s)</u>: The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee acknowledged the update on BCCM Secretariat's Costed workplan.

Agenda Item #8: AOB - Payment of Transport Allowance (TA) to Government PRs GoB Staff.

<u>PR representative(s):</u> Dr. Shah Mohammad Jashim Uddin, Director, ASP raised the issue of Transport Allowance (TA) payment to GoB staff of government PRs. He explained that GoB Staff working in Government PRs do not receive any benefit from The Global Fund. BCCM Secretariat also do not pay any TA to them though they pay to MOHFW and DGHS staff while attending same meeting.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed the meeting that The Global Fund policy do not permit any payment to the staff who receives benefit from The Global Fund.

<u>Oversight Committee member(s)</u>: Dr. Asif Mujtaba Mahmud opined that PRs GoB staff should be treated as independent as they do not receive any benefit from The Global Fund.

<u>PR representative(s):</u> Md. Akhtaruzzaman, Senior Manager, ASP replied that pervious grants have provision to pay mobile bills to GoB Staff but current grant do not have this option.

BCCM Secretariat: BCCM Coordinator informed that BCCM Secretariat will be able to pay if Oversight Committee decide accordingly. But before payment, written declaration is required to inform the list of GoB employees, listed to represent in BCCM, who do not receive any financial benefit from The Global Fund grants.

<u>Chair of the meeting:</u> The Chairperson of the meeting requested BCCM Coordinator to communicate with PRs to collect necessary declaration and arrange payment of TA to the GoB Staff of government PRs.

<u>Decision(s)</u>: The 46th meeting of BCCM Oversight Committee directed BCCM Secretariat to collect necessary declaration from the PR Representatives and arrange payment of TA to the GoB Staff of Government PRs if they do not receive any salary and benefits from GF Grants respectively in their disease components and grants.

Having no other issues to discuss, the Chairperson thanked all participants for their attendance and active participation and wrapped up the meeting.




