**Nomination of Candidates and Election of Civil Society Representatives  
to the Bangladesh Country Coordinating Mechanism (BCCM)**

Deadline: 25 February 2023

**Bangladesh Country Coordination Mechanism (BCCM) Secretariat** is coordinating and overseeing the election process of Civil Society Members and alternate members to the Bangladesh Country Coordinating Mechanism (BCCM). Civil Society constituencies will **elect their members and alternate members according to BCCM governance manual and election criteria**. Organizations and individual are requested to send necessary documents to the given email address in election criteria or address below if you are eligible as per the constituencies criteria. You can also download the detail guideline and criteria from the website link below.

**Country Coordinating Mechanisms:** CCMs are partnerships consisting of representatives from both the public and civil society sectors who coordinate the submission of national proposals on the basis of priority needs to the Global Fund to fight AIDS, TB and malaria. In addition, CCMs are responsible for overseeing the progress of program implementation. The CCM [is] a central pillar of the Global Fund's architecture to ensure country-driven, coordinated, and multi-sectoral processes for leveraging and effecting additional resources to fight AIDS, TB and malaria. BCCM consists of 33 members, with representation from both the public and private sectors, including fourteen (14) from government, four (4) multilateral and bilateral organizations and fifteen (15) from Civil Society Organizations. Of the 15 Civil Society Organizations four(4) are from NGOs, two (2) from academics, two (2) from private sector, three (3) from key affected populations 3 (KAP TB-1, KAP Malaria-1 and KAP HIV-1) and three (3) from people living with the diseases (PLWD TB-1, PLWD Malria-1 and PLHIV -1) as well as one (1) from Faith Based Organization (BHBCOP).

For each grant, the Country Coordinating Mechanism (CCM) selects one or more public or private organizations to serve as Principal Recipients. In addition, it is responsible for overseeing the implementation of all Global Fund grants.

**Election Process:** Details of election process and criteria including voter registration date and process, election date and application form are available on BCCM Election website ([www.bccmbd.org](http://www.bccmbd.org)) and BCCM Facebook page.

**Registration and election:** All CSO Constituency need to complete their voter registrations, voting and election of their members and alternate members by 25<sup>th</sup> February 2023 and nomination of elected member and alternate member with formal letter to BCCM Chair by 28 February 2023 along with all election evidences and documentations. The Global Fund assigned an international non-government organization APCASO for conducting and documenting the key affected populations 3 (KAP TB-1, KAP Malaria-1 and KAP HIV-1) and three (3) from people living with the diseases (PLWD TB-1, PLWD Malria-1 and PLHIV-1) constituencies. **APCASO consultant will communicate with** key affected populations 3 (KAP TB-1, KAP Malaria-1 and KAP HIV-1) and three (3) from people living with the diseases (PLWD TB-1, PLWD Malria-1 and PLHIV-1) constituencies for providing election related support (criteria, election process, voter listing, candidate nomination for election, conduction of election etc.)

UNAIDS and USAID provided consultants will provide necessary support for NGO and other CSO constituencies election (criteria, election process, voter listing, candidate nomination for election, conduction of election etc.)

- Deadline of voter and candidate registration for NGOs and KAPs (PWID, MSM/Hijra, CSW, CBOs working for Malaria) will fix by constituencies themselves but not later than 20<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Constituencies' election criteria, election date will be published by constituencies themselves and will be available in respective constituency website/ BCCM website.
- NGO Constituency election will be done through online voting. Online Voting link will be informed to all registered voter through their email.
- Faith Based Organization's Election will be conducted by BHBCOP and election date is available on BHBCOP website
- PLWD HIV (PLHIV) constituency election will be conducted by PLHIV Network and election date will be available on BCCM Election website after fixing date by PLHIV network
- PLWD Malaria constituency election will be conducted by Hill District Council (Bandarban and Rangamati) and election date is available on Hill District Council website
- PLWD TB Constituency election will be conducted by NATAB and election date is available on NATAB website
- Academia and private sector member selection will be by BCCM Oversight Committee based on the renowned academia, researchers, and private corporate companies EOI to become members or alternate members for BCCM
